Not an impersonator, Toni Morrell is a unique performer who salutes these ladies by performing songs in her own inimitable style.

Along with her Musical Director and husband, David Dial, Toni starred in her multi-media concert, *Toni Morrell – Now That’s An Entertainer - Featuring A Salute to the Legendary Ladies* and her autobiographical One-Woman Show, *My British-American Dream...“What The Hell Was I Thinking?”* winning rave reviews from critics and audiences alike. Toni was the voice-over spokesperson worldwide for the Pixar/Walt Disney motion picture, *Tinker Bell*. Her voice can also be heard

throughout Las Vegas promoting a major new production on the “Miracle Mile.”

The Musical Director for **REMEMBERING THE LADIES** is award-winning, multi-keyboard “wizard”, **David Dial**. David is a Musician, Producer, Composer, Arranger-Orchestrator and Sound Engineer and is solely responsible for all the musical and technical aspects of **REMEMBERING THE LADIES**. David has worked with such luminaries as Burt Bacharach, Peter Allen and James Darren. He served as Musical Director for the Southern California production of Neal Simon’s Broadway Musical, *“They’re Playing Our Song”* and more recently as Musical Director for *“Razzle Dazzle”* starring Carol Channing and co-starring Toni Morrell. David has composed and produced music for documentaries, commercials and television and was awarded the *Jeannie Star Sapphire Award for Excellence as a Composer and Producer* by the Southern California Motion Picture Council.

With over twenty years of producing and directing some of the most noted stars in the world, Producer/Director **Karen G. Cadle** has gained recognition for her work with the Legendary Ladies of Stage, Screen, and Film. As a veteran national television Producer and DGA Director, she has produced and directed hundreds of celebrity interviews, including: Robert Redford, Liza Minnelli, Prince Charles, Carol Burnett, Cher, and Presidents Ronald Reagan, Jimmy Carter, and Gerald Ford. She has also produced one-hour specials for television with such Legendary Ladies as: **Audrey Hepburn, Sophia Loren, Lana Turner, Doris Day, Bette Davis, Joan Fontaine, and Elizabeth Taylor.**

El Portal Theatre is a historic landmark in the San Fernando Valley located in the heart of No Ho Arts District. The theatre, originally built as a vaudeville house in 1926, sits across Lankershim Blvd from the Academy of Television Arts and Sciences and the Art Institute of California-Hollywood. Since its opening in 1926 -- first for Vaudeville, then Silent Movies, and then Academy Award-winning films -- as the primo movie house in the valley, the theatre has weathered the Jazz Age, the Depression, 4 wars, and finally the great earthquake of 1994. Rebuilt in the late 90's and opened in January of 2000, the once 1400-seat movie palace now houses three theatres -- the 42-seat Studio Theatre the 95-seat Forum, and the 360-seat Main Stage -- along with the Judith Kaufman Art Gallery, featuring many of Los Angeles visual artists.
